PMEMS provides primary coverage to the Port Matilda Borough, Halfmoon, Huston, Taylor, Worth, and parts of Ferguson Townships. Copies of PMEMS's Privacy Policy may be obtained by contacting the service.

Important Information

- The subscription year is January 1 through December 31, 2012.
- A subscription entitles the holder to unlimited *emergency* service on a *manpower available* basis.
- Subscribers will incur no out-of-pocket expenses, including services provided by Mount Nittany Medical Center paramedics or Centre LifeLink Emergency Medical Services paramedics, for any emergency when transported by PMEMS to the closest receiving facility based upon the patient's condition.
- Non-emergency transports must be ordered by physician and the member is responsible for charges not covered by insurance.
- Members and non-members evaluated by ambulance personnel, then refusing transport or do not require transport will be charged our standard refusal fee of \$200.

Third Party Billing

Third party billing is a program that provides reimbursement for ambulance service. Your subscription assures that you will NOT be responsible for any additional bills for *emergency* service provided by PMEMS regardless of your insurance coverage. Each time you use the ambulance, a bill is submitted to your insurance company. If your insurance company reimburses any portion of that bill, we accept it as payment in full. However, if you are not a subscriber, you must pay any amount not covered by your insurance. Non-payment may result in litigation through the district magistrate. Insurance reimbursements made directly to the patient and not forwarded to PMEMS voids your membership and collection procedures may be initiated by PMEMS.

Port Matilda EMS is an ambulance service that provides emergency medical care to the residents of the Port Matilda Borough, Halfmoon, Huston, Taylor, Worth, and sections of Ferguson Townships. Our station, on High Street in the Borough of Port Matilda, is located centrally within the coverage area. Port Matilda EMS has two fully equipped basic life support ambulances ready to respond to emergencies on a manpower available basis. There is a crew on station twelve hours a day, with the remaining twelve hours covered by volunteers who respond from home. The volunteers and employees of PMEMS strive to provide all persons with the most professional care possible.

Our Emergency Medical Technicians are skilled medical workers who respond by ambulance to emergencies for the injured and ill. People's lives depend on the quick reaction of these workers. From vehicle accidents to heart attacks, from childbirth to traumatic injuries, PMEMS responds at all times of the day and night to provide immediate medical attention.

State regulations require regular training for emergency workers to maintain their certification. Volunteers and employees of PMEMS regularly go above and beyond the required training to provide better care to our patients. Our company is proud to be made up of individuals who have a strong commitment to serving the community.
